

Early Phase

Grant writing consultation regarding community engagement/community based participatory research

How to include community engagement in your grant proposal, including how to write a community impact statement.

Facilitating community partnerships

Help identifying and connecting you with community partners who have an interest in your area of study.

Technical assistance on IRB as related to community engagement

Consultation on how to include community engagement in your IRB application, including, for example, recruitment materials and data report-back to research participants.

Ongoing

Consultation on planning community meetings

How to prepare for a community meeting: what to expect when going into the community, how to manage audience participation, etc.

Facilitating community partnerships

Consultation on how to maintain community partnerships.

Evaluating your community partnerships

Guidance in developing an evaluation plan to assess your project's community engagement activities.

Report-back

Guidance on reporting results back to both individual participants and the community.

**Translation/
Dissemination**

Consultation on planning community meetings (*see above*)

Research translation

Iterative development of lay summaries and/or infographics to communicate your research to a wider audience. These can include the 1-pagers, infographics, or research highlights found on the HERCULES website. Translations can be used at community meetings, events, and posted to the web (including the HERCULES website).

Media training

External training on how to communicate your research findings with the media.
