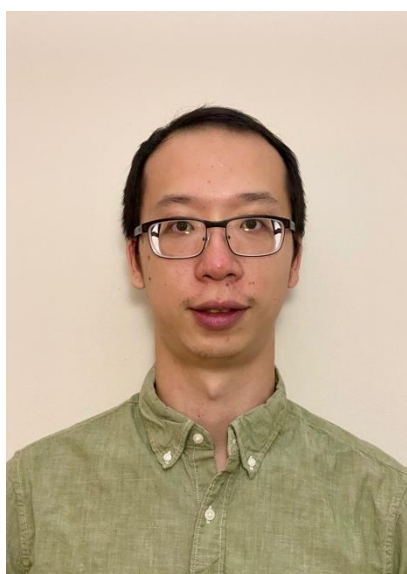

Dr. Gao is an analytical chemist trained in both environmental and biological sciences. His research focuses on multidisciplinary areas in environmental chemistry, analytical chemistry, and environmental health sciences. Specifically, he is interested in targeted and non-targeted analyses of chemical and biological stressors in environmental and biological samples; determinations of combined contaminations, exposures, and toxicities of multiple stressors; interactions between the exposome and internal multi-omics; and the applications of the exposome on human health risk assessments and idiopathic diseases. Dr. Gao has published in various top environmental science journals, peer-reviewed hundreds of articles, and currently serving as an editorial board member of the Chemosphere.
